To Enter

• Send the completed entry form to the team via Facebook/Instagram messenger, email(equestrian.hunterjumper@oregonstate.edu), or mail to Dixon (Oregon State University 211 Dixon Recreation Center Corvallis, Oregon 97331). There are two waivers to fill out show day. Parents MUST be present to sign for minors. Waivers can be sent via email ahead of time if requested.

To Pay

- Mark the payment method on the entry form. If you select "cash/check" it can
 be sent with your mailed entry or dropped off at Dixon to pre-pay or you can
 pay with cash/check on show day. If you select "card" a link will be emailed to
 you to pre-pay. Card payments will NOT be available via the link on show day.
- Checks to "Oregon State University", "Hunter Jumper Team" on the memo line
 - \$20 office fee per horse/rider combination
 - Pre-pay (paid before 4/25) is \$15 per class or \$10 per schooling round, after 4/25 it will be \$20 per class and \$15 per schooling round

General Information

- Course walk open 7:30-8am on show day & between jump classes
- Any show changes/updates will be posted on the Facebook event & emailed to entered participants. Information can also be found on our website under "Events"
- No day of entries or class additions. Entries must be sent by Friday 4/25
- Check-in & warm-up will open at 7:30 am on the show day
- Ride times & Course maps will be released on 4/30
- KL Pet Prints will be the photographer. Photos will be posted on their website.



Facility

- Inavale Farms, 31786 Horse Farm Lane Philomath, OR 97370
- Round pen & crossties reserved for Inavale boarders ONLY
- Warm up in a covered arena. Show in an uncovered sand arena.
- Show & warm-up arenas may be switched in the event of extreme weather
- A limited amount of uncovered overnight stalls are available, contact the team email for more info & reservations. Stalls are free of charge. Anyone staying overnight is NOT permitted to walk/ride/lunge in any Inavale arena until warm-up opens at 7:30 am on Sunday

Class/Division Descriptions

- Trot a Pole: pile of poles. Judged on equitation. Instructor assistance or leadline is allowed but will result in disqualification from ribbons. Trot a Pole will have a shorter course than jumper classes. Ribbons for 1st-5th, prize for 1st place.
- Jumper Classes: Judged on lowest faults & fastest time. No jump-off. Ribbons for 1st-5th, prize for 1st place.
 - There will be different courses for Jumpers A & B. Course B is of greater difficulty.
- Schooling rounds: **Must follow** the B course or a portion of the B course route, or flat. Schooling rounds will have a time limit (approx. 2 minutes). No ribbons or prizes for schooling rounds.
- Gambler's Choice: Jumps will be set at varied heights within the designated range. The rider accumulates points by jumping the different jumps within the 45-second time limit. There is no set course. Each jump can only be jumped twice. A list of point assignments for jumps will be provided, and will be based on height. Ribbons for 1st-3rd, prize for 1st place.

General Rules

- Unsafe riding or riding of unhealthy horses is not allowed. A judge may remove you from the competition if they feel either is occurring.
- Do not enter the warm-up arena if the horse/rider cannot safely be in a busy arena. Anyone creating an unsafe arena will be asked to leave.
- The warm-up arena will be monitored & there will be a rider limit. Ride times will determine the priority for the warm-up arena if the rider limit is reached.
- No lunging in the warm-up arena unless the warm-up steward gives permission.
- The competitor number must be on the horse or rider/handler while in any arena.
- The USEF Rulebook's Jumper Division will be used for consulting purposes.
- Class entries are for riders. Riders may not sub in for another rider under any circumstance.



- If the horse on the entry is unable to be used for any reason, horse changes may be allowed with prior notice and permission from the judge.
- Refunds will not be given for scratches

Equipment/Dress Requirements

- A bridle & English saddle are required for all classes.
- A helmet & boots with a heel are required while mounted.
- Closed-toed shoes are required for anyone leading a horse in an arena.
